Adrian Granda reported that Todd's team has one more year representing District 3 — there is still plenty of time to do great things! Climate Action plan was passed unanimously — 100% clean energy by 2025 with measurable and enforceable steps to make sustainable changes in San Diego. Improvements to the Storefront Improvement Program — Art element has been removed, but now there is a higher threshold of money available. "Small Business" staff count was raised from 15 to 25 to allow for more participation. Red Sidewalk Project has begun and should last about 45 days. Team is working hard to keep communication open with the business owners. Community Workshop on January 14.
