NPMS met with Civic San Diego to discuss progress on the Woolworths project to redevelop the property. The City and the County continue to work out an agreement. The most significant impact of that is the statutory requirement that the City enter into a Compensation Agreement with the Affected Taxing Entities (ATE's) prior to the disposition of the property. The City is in the process of negotiating this/these Agreements starting with the County and they hope to complete this process by the end of the year.

BUSINESS and COMMUNITY OUTREACH

NPMS continues to work with City staff on oversight of the North Park Maintenance Assessment District which is run by the City. The City's current contractor, Landcare Logic, is resigning from their contract and an interim contractor will be selected to fill in until a new permanent contract will be awarded.
